Assembly Bill (AB) 1806 modifies the graduation requirements for students identified as McKinney-Vento (MKV) eligible and change schools after their second year in high school. Eligibility as a MKV student is made by district homeless liaisons. Criteria is available on our website – **NJUHSD.com** The District shall exempt each qualifying 11th and 12th grade student from all coursework and other requirements that are <u>in addition</u> to the statewide coursework requirements, unless the District finds the student is reasonably able to complete the additional requirements in time to graduate. **Students may not graduate early using AB 1806 reduced graduation requirements**.
