

The criteria for this scholarship are:

1. Membership in
 - 1.1. Job's Daughters Bethel #102
 - 1.2. Rainbow Girls Assembly #74
 - 1.3. DeMolay of North Star Chapter #73030.
2. Applicant must be a member in good standing.
 - 2.1. Defined as having dues paid
 - 2.2. Not having disciplinary action that would otherwise infringe on good standing.
 - 2.3. Membership for six (6) months minimum depending on activity level from time of initiation.
3. Open to graduating seniors at any high school.
4. GPA of 2.5 or better.
5. Applications are available from;
 - 5.1. In the district Scholarship packet.
 - 5.2. From any member of the Bethel Council.
6. Due date; Application must be returned with completed district scholarship application by High School due date.
 - 6.1. If you received the application from a council member the due date is the council meeting of April.
Returned to a Bethel Council member.
7. Qualifying schools;
 - 7.1. Four year college
 - 7.2. Community college
 - 7.3. Accredited trade schools
8. Units per year. Full time (as defined by the school) or equivalent.
 - 8.1. Part time students can receive a smaller amount as a one-time award. The Bethel will not split a scholarship into two halves.

Applicant selection

1. Participation in youth group. Based on advisors input – variable weight.
2. Priority
 - 2.1. Job's Daughters have the highest priority.
 - 2.1.1. Rainbow girls and DeMolay have equal priority with each other.
3. Written essay. This is part of the application and must meet the following;
 - 3.1. Answer the question "What did you get out of your youth organization"?
 - 3.1.1. There is no word count but the question must be answered.
 - 3.1.2. There is a medium to high importance on this question.
 - 3.1.3. Grading is based on;
 - 3.1.3.1. Overall essay
 - 3.1.3.2. Spelling
 - 3.1.3.3. Correct use of punctuation.
4. Voting will be done by the Bethel Guardian Council. The Council has final say on the recipients.
 - 4.1. Council members who have children applying are not eligible to vote.
5. The scholarship check will be written to the school.
 - 5.1. The Bethel will hold the funds up to December 31 of the year the scholarship was awarded.
 - 5.2. Limited exceptions will be made if the school has no student account or tuition has been paid.
6. The award will be made at the high school's award night.
 - 6.1. The Bethel will also have an award night to celebrate the winners.
