Jeffery Robert Lamb 1965-1988

Our son, Jeff was the oldest of our four children, which probably explains why he liked to be the center of attention, but at the same time, always sharing and helping those who needed it. His love of cars and mechanics began as a toddler; and he put together his first car at 16. His sometimes outrageous sense of humor, sharp wit and perfect timing wasn't always welcome as a student, and even though most of the teachers really liked him, it was his learning disabilities that determined that he would be sent to Sierra Mountain School. It was only a very small house on Bennet St., but Jeff and the other students and teachers made it into a learning center that they were proud of.

Always having a strong sense of fair play, he was a champion of the underdog. He loved his friends and family and kept an eye out for his younger teen siblings. His life ended when his truck lost its brakes while coming down a mountain road. Our family, including both sets of grandparents, and friends decided that a Memorial Fund be set up in Jeff's name to benefit those that need help with their learning as he did, and to pay tribute to him as a loving son, brother, grandson and good friend to so many.
