Instructions for Teachers and Students

Thank you for participating in the 2017-2018 Rotary District 5190 Speech Contest.

Important Points to Know

1. In most areas, the speech contest has three levels. First is the local club contest, held between February and March, 2018. The second is an area contest, held between March and April, 2018. The final level is the District Speech Contest, to be held at the District Conference on May 19, 2018, 9:30am at Atlantis Casino Resort Spa, Reno, NV. **STUDENTS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL THREE LEVELS TO ENTER IN THE COMPETITION.**
2. Only the winner at each level advances to the next level. Club and area contests have 2-5 contestants; the District contest has 7-13. The cash prizes at the district level are \$1,000 (1st), \$750 (2nd) and \$500 (3rd). Club and area prizes are the responsibility of the participating clubs.
3. Contest rules are available at your local school or Rotary club.
4. Your local Rotary club is responsible for furnishing you with all of the information needed to compete at each level of the contest.
5. A student may enter only one club contest in their own area.

| Arrival Time: | All contestants MUST arrive at contest location NO LATER than 10 minutes before the start of the contest. Late arrivals will be DISQUALIFIED. NO EXCEPTIONS. |
