1. As many of you now know, we will be transitioning to our distance learning model of instructional delivery model, beginning next Wednesday, March 25th. Teachers and staff will be working to develop distance learning assignments and materials on Monday and Tuesday of next week, with materials being made available by Wednesday the 25th, at the latest. The primary means for providing assignments to students will be via their student email account. If your student has challenges accessing an internet signal, please notify your student's school and paper materials will be made available.

2. Our Nutrition and Food Services program will be making meals available to all students 18 years of age and younger for the coming two Tuesdays. This service will be provided for the next two weeks, with drive thru pickups of meal bags being provided at Nevada Union and Bear River High Schools parking lots, between 11:30 and 1:00 (March 24th and March 31st). Each bag contains 4 breakfasts and 4 lunches. One bag will be available for each child in the vehicle (children must be present in order for meals to be provided).
