Public Safety Power Shutoffs

- Six (6) closure days have been implemented so far.
- Two (2) “snow days” are built into the 19-20 calendar.
- Projections show no “Red Flag” weather conditions for the next week.
- The district has the operational capabilities for “shut offs and ons”
 - Network can run and be protected
 - Protocols are in place
 - **Negative impacts** - staff, families, instruction, student achievement



School closures - Developing plans

Overview:

- Need to coordinate with other districts / NCSOS
- Need to maximize instructional effectiveness, student/staff safety, operational needs

Short term:

- Seek ways to recapture instructional minutes in FY 19-20
- Push back Fall semester to after break? Ending 1/17
- Facility items - generators, network, emergency ops center

Long term:

- Negotiate new calendar for 20-21 add 5+ closure days (i.e. snow days)
- Facility matters - battery storage via solar?
- Develop a calendar like they have in other states / regions?
